1. The AJHA Provincial Show is open to all Junior Hereford members who have paid their annual activity fee.

Age Categories

(All ages are as of January 1st of current calendar year)

Pee Wee - 8 years old & under

Junior - 9 - 12 years old

Intermediate - 13 - 16 years old

Senior - 17 - 21 years old

2. All purebred animals entered must have a photocopy of the original registration certificate. Animals must be registered in Canada with the Canadian Hereford Association. All animals including calves must be legibly tattooed and have RFID tags in place. Animals that do not fulfill these requirements will be disqualified. Junior members must show all animals.

3. Commercial cattle must be of strong Hereford influence. This will be left to the discretion of the AJHA show committee. Please send a picture of the animal(s) with the completed entry form. When entering a cow with a calf at side, both animals must exhibit strong Hereford characteristics. Commercial entries are eligible to show in the commercial classes as well as showmanship and grooming.

4. Owner of animal must be a registered exhibitor and be in attendance of the AJHA Provincial Show. All junior members must show only his or her animals with the following exceptions:

A. Grooming and Showmanship- only if a junior member does not have an animal at the show.

B. If a junior member has more than one animal in the same class.

C. In the open show, the animal does not have to be in the junior's name if the animal is owned by the junior's Grandparent, parent or sibling.

D. In the open show, the animal does not have to be transferred into the junior's name if the animal is under a family farm name.

E. In the bred and owned show the animal must be bred and owned by the junior showing.

5. Cattle entry fee is \$15.00/ head. Cow/calf entries are considered one entry unless the calf is entered separately in the calf class. All entry fees must accompany the entry forms and the cheques should be payable to the AJHA. There is no fee for showmanship, grooming or judging. When animals are entered in both the open show and bred & owned they will only pay one entry fee. No entry fee for group classes, but animals must be shown in individual classes. There is a \$30.00 participant fee to be paid at time of entry this will pay for the pizza supper and subway for the kids. We will also have water bottles and juice for the kids.

6. There is no limit placed on the number of entries per member in each class. Classes will be determined following the entry deadline.

7. A copy of or the original registration certificates must accompany all cattle to the show. All tattoos will be checked upon arrival. All animals must be broke to lead. All yearling and two-year old bulls must have a ring in their nose. Any unruly cattle that pose a danger must be removed from the show.

8. All members are required to wear AJHA provincial show shirt while participating in events. Shirts should be ordered at time of entry to ensure correct size is available.

9. Cattle must be in place by the time specified on the schedule and will be released following the conclusion of the show.

10. Calves shown with their dam are eligible to enter the calf classes. Heifer calves that win the honor of Grand or Reserve Champion must be shown on their dam if their dam also wins Senior or Reserve Senior Champion. Registration papers and tattoos are required for all calves including those shown solely at side of dam.

11. Tampering with cattle is strictly prohibited.

12. The AJHA committee reserves the right to determine eligibility of all entries if requirements are not met.

13. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN, AT ACTIVITIES OR COMPETITIONS!

14. Embryo transfer calves that have been incubated in utero within a recipient female cannot be shown with the genetic donor dam.

15. Entries must be submitted before entry deadline.

16. ADULT PARTICIPATION IS NOT ALLOWED.

17. All animals must be free of any transmissible or zoonotic disease.

18. The AJHA and/or its members are not responsible accidents or losses that may occur. All juniors attending do so at their own risk.

Team Grooming

Each Team consists of at least 1 Pee Wee or Junior, 1 Intermediate & 1 Senior. The team will groom one animal in 20 minutes, and display this animal in the show ring.
